Small projects for NWA routes 21/22

Deadline for applications: 10 May 2022

Budget: €7,500,000

Description:

Within this call for proposals, the route management of each NWA route can apply for funding for up to 3 small projects. These projects focus on an innovative idea, promotion of utilization of existing knowledge or synthesis of existing knowledge.

The projects should contribute to topics relevant to the route and align with the route's knowledge agenda, ambitions and gamechangers. The route management should go through a transparent process to arrive at a selection of the proposed subprojects together with its route network and should describe this process in the application. New and innovative connections should also be made for example between disciplines, organizations and research fields.

Routes can apply up to a maximum of $\in 300,000$ for a project. A project consists of a maximum of three sub-projects of at least $\in 50,000$ and at most $\in 150,000$ each. The maximum duration of the total project is 2 years.



RAAK-public June and November 2022

Deadline for applications: 21 June 2022

Description:

Professors of applied sciences and researchers from universities of applied sciences conduct research together with professionals working in the public sector. This leads to knowledge and innovations that contribute to solving social issues.

The RAAK-publick scheme promotes cooperation between professionals working in the public sector and universities of applied sciences. The focus of the collaboration is on knowledge development and application. Driven by the demand from professionals, networks of universities of applied sciences and professionals carry out research. The result of the research is practical knowledge for the professional practice. The research also provides a demonstrable contribution to the renewal of higher vocational education.

The maximum grant size is 300.000,- euro. The project duration is max. 24 months.



Research Grants on Education: Large

Deadline for applications: May 4, 2022 (intent to apply); June 15, 2022 (full proposal)

Budget: \$125,000 to \$500,000

Description:

The Large Research Grants on Education Program supports education research projects that will contribute to the improvement of education, broadly conceived, with budgets ranging from \$125,000 up through \$500,000 for projects ranging from one to five years. We accept applications twice a year.

This program is "field-initiated," meaning that proposal submissions are not in response to a specific request for a particular research topic, discipline, design, or method. Our goal for this program is to support rigorous, intellectually ambitious and technically sound research that is relevant to the most pressing questions and compelling opportunities in education. We seek to support scholarship that develops new foundational knowledge that may have a lasting impact on educational discourse.



City Deal Getting to Know 2023

Description:

The main goal of the City Deal Knowledge Making (CDKM) is to accelerate the solution of social challenges in the cities through better cooperation between city government and knowledge institutions. This by involving researchers, lecturers and students on a large scale.

In this call for proposals you can apply for a maximum of \in 500,000. The program has a maximum duration of 36 months and starts from April 15, 2023, with a final start date of June 1, 2023.

The applications are assessed by the assessment committee on the basis of the three assessment criteria below:

- Effectiveness of the chosen approach
- Networking
- Feasibility, feasibility and efficiency
