

Description:

The Small Research Grants Program supports education research projects that will contribute to the improvement of education, broadly conceived, with budgets up to \$50,000 for projects ranging from one to five years. We accept applications three times per year.

This program is "field-initiated" in that proposal submissions are not in response to a specific request for a particular research topic, discipline, design, method, or location. Our goal for this program is to support rigorous, intellectually ambitious and technically sound research that is relevant to the most pressing questions and compelling opportunities in education.

Description:

The Research-Practice Partnership (RPP) Grants Program is intended to support education research projects that engage in collaborative and participatory partnerships with project budgets up to \$400,000 and durations of up to three years. We accept Intent to Apply forms once a year in this program.

We view partnerships as an important approach to knowledge generation and the improvement of education, broadly construed. Over the long term, we anticipate that research conducted by RPPs will result in new insights into the processes, practices, and policies that improve education for learners, educators, families, communities, and institutions where learning and teaching happen (e.g., schools, universities, museums, other workplaces).

Significant questions in higher education

Description:

The primary aim of practice-oriented research in higher education, as financed by the NRO, is to answer questions that arise in the field of higher education. The program committee higher education aims to stimulate research towards questions that will be relevant for the entire higher education sector in the Netherlands for the upcoming \pm 10 years. The research projects are relevant for education at both research universities and universities of applied sciences. In this way the research aims to improve and innovate higher education.

Applications can be submitted by consortia consisting of project leader(s), education researchers, lecturer-researcher and other professionals working in institutions of higher education.

For an application in this Call for proposals, applicants can apply for fund with a minimum of $\in 850.000$ a maximum of $\in 900.000$.



Kennisbenutting Plus

Deadline for applications: Continuous

Budget: €100.000

Description:

Hoofdaanvragers van een lopend of net afgerond NRO-project kunnen een aanvraag indienen voor financiering van producten of activiteiten die de kennisbenutting van hun onderzoeksproject bevorderen. Aanvragen worden samen met een partner uit praktijk of beleid ingediend.

Aanvragen voor NRO Kennisbenutting Plus worden ingediend door de hoofdaanvrager van een lopend of net afgerond NRO-project, samen met een of meer partners uit praktijk of beleid. Dit kan een partner zijn uit het bestaande onderzoeksconsortium, maar het mag ook een nieuwe partner zijn.

Het totaal beschikbare budget voor NRO Kennisbenutting Plus is 50.000 euro per jaar. Het aan te vragen budget per project bedraagt maximaal 10.000 euro. De financiering wordt verstrekt in de vorm van een lump sum vergoeding voor de termijn van maximaal 12 maanden.

Description:

Researchers who want to apply knowledge from their research and bring it to the market can apply for funding from NWO to further develop this knowledge into a Demonstrator. In a Demonstrator project, all preparatory activities are carried out that are necessary to transfer the underlying Demonstrator knowledge to a third party.

Teachers and lecturers at a Dutch university of applied sciences can submit an application. Full, associate and assistant professors and other researchers with a comparable position may submit an application if they have a tenured position.

A maximum of € 160,000 (including VAT) can be requested for a proposal in this call. A Demonstrator project has a maximum duration of 18 months.
